1. Cast on 100 stitches. 2. Knit in stockinette stitch (knit every row) for 6 inches. 3. Begin decreasing by knitting 2 stitches together every 6th row. 4. Repeat Step 3 until there are 10 stitches remaining. 5. Cut the yarn, leaving a tail for sewing. 6. Thread the yarn through the remaining stitches and pull to close the top of the hat. 7. Sew the faux fur pompom to the top of the hat.

Tips and Variations

* For a closer fit, use a smaller size of needles or a heavier weight of yarn.

* For a looser fit, use a larger size of needles or a lighter weight of yarn. *

Add a brim to the beanie by knitting a few additional rows in rib stitch before beginning the decreases. * Embroider or embellish the beanie and hat with beads, sequins, or other decorative items.
