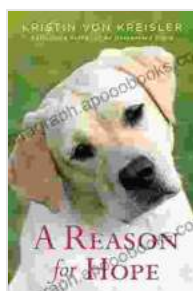


# Reason For Hope: A Novel of the Holocaust

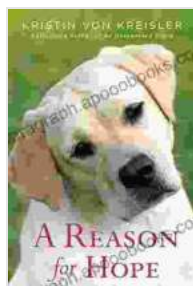
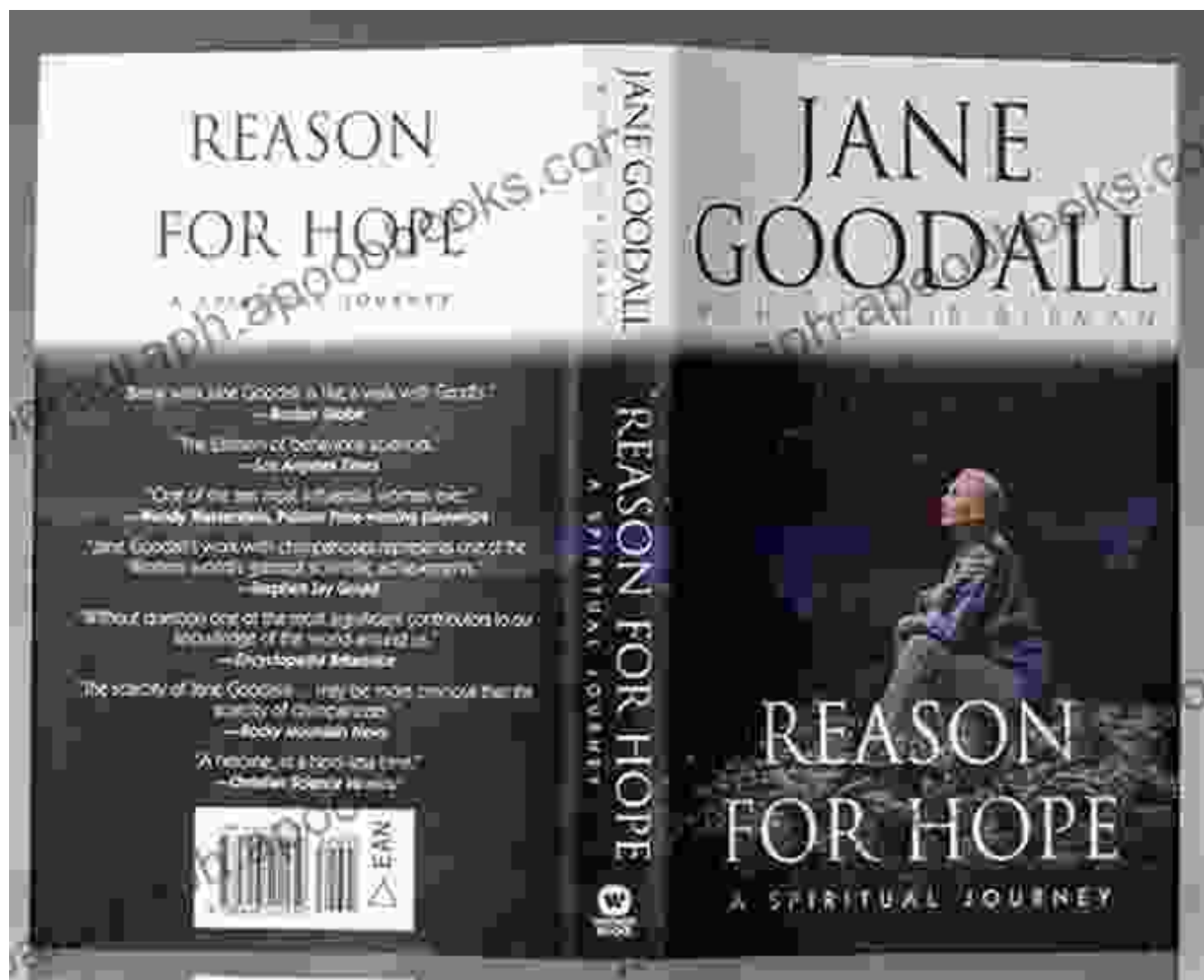

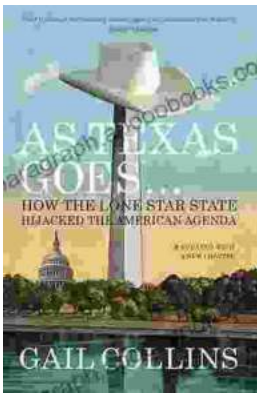
